

## **Immunizations Requirements**

### **Kindergarten ☐ 7<sup>th</sup> Graders ☐ All Newly Enrolled Students**

The Michigan Public Health Code (Act 368 of 1978) states that all kindergarten, 7<sup>th</sup> grade, and all newly enrolled students must provide proof of immunization. Parents/guardians must show the district proof of student's immunization record by the 1<sup>st</sup> day of school. Parents/guardian may also submit proof of medical or non-medical waiver by the 1<sup>st</sup> day of school.
